Projects and Operations

Corporal Justin Pearson responded to a person down in the roadway. Upon arrival he found a person down who appeared to be under the influence of narcotics and was unresponsive. Corporal Pearson assisted in the administration of NARCAN by EMS, and the person become responsive and was transported to a local hospital by EMS.

Corporal Pearson was dispatched to a person down. The person was not breathing and had no pulse. He performed CPR until EMS arrived. A pulse was restored by EMS personnel, and the patient was alive upon arrival at the hospital.

Colonel Smith, Corporal Pearson, and Chief Money investigated a motor vehicle crash in front of Town Hall in which a fire hydrant, street sign, and telephone pole were destroyed or damaged. The driver was cited for DUI and open container. The driver and passenger were transported to a local hospital by EMS.

Colonel Smith reports that 71% of the properties not in compliance with the Town Health and Safety Codes have come into compliance. For those remaining a special court date may be established to encourage compliance.

Chief Money and Colonel Smith are investigating an arson of an abandoned mobile home. The case is ongoing. This was one of the structures not in compliance with the Town Health and Safety Codes.
