Mayor Coachman opened the meeting at 6:00 P. M. leading the prayer followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Cottonwood Ambulance & Rescue used 13,979 gallons of water for the month of November.

Approval to purchase base rock for Butler St from North Florida Rock for \$900.00. Council Member Capehart made a motion to approve the reports as presented. A second by Council Member Granger and the motion was approved unanimously.

Roll Call Vote on interpretation on Ordinance 2021-014 Tiny House, Tents, Boarding Houses, Bed and Breakfast, Hotels, Motels, etc. It was voted to add single family residents into the ordinance. Roll Call Vote: Capehart -yes, Hackney -yes, Free -yes, Granger -no, Stringer -yes, Mayor Coachman -yes. Majority Yes.

Council Members were made aware of a citizen, Danielle Wade, hitting a pothole on Houston St and damaged her back driver side tire and rim.

Chief Money announced to the Mayor and Council that ACOM and Southeast Medical Center have joined together with our Police Department in a self defense class for the students and staff. The self defense course has made it to the Federal Level. It could be used as a pilot as a nationwide program.

Mayor Coachman announced the Senior Center, Fire Department, and Pageant Committee are hosting the Down Home Christmas on December 17, 2023, at the Senior Center parking lot.
