Projects and Operations

Colonel Smith, Chief Money, and Officer Pearson investigated a shooting. The investigation revealed that the firearm discharge was unintentional. The injuries were classified as moderate and not life threatening.

Colonel Smith and Chief Money investigated a threat against a local government official. The investigation is ongoing with a suspect identified.

A grant application for Threat Level IV body armor and a Threat Level IV ballistic shield was submitted to ADECA for the Byrne Memorial monies. The request was for \$8,000.

Chief Money made three arrests on warrants. Chief Money and Colonel Smith investigated a counterfeit bill passed in Cottonwood, and the case was referred to USSS.

Colonel Smith investigated a motor vehicle crash and made an arrest on a warrant.

Corporal Pearson investigated two domestic violence cases. He also investigated runaway juvenile where the parent declined to sign a complaint. He also made three arrests on warrants.

Chief Money and Colonel Smith investigated a criminal trespass, but the party declined prosecution. Colonel Smith and Chief Money investigated identity theft of a person and an unrelated forgery involving a local business.
