Projects and Operations

Chief Money, Corporal Pearson and Officer Dale Davis assisted Alabama College of Osteopathic Medicine with training as part of the ACOM outreach program situational awareness and self-defense.

Officers controlled traffic for the Homecoming Pep Rally.

Corporal Pearson investigated two unrelated harassment cases, but the victims elected not to prosecute. He also investigated an adult missing person.

Cottonwood Police Department received monies that paid for a portion of the replacement of body armor for two officers. The latest grant award this month will allow the replacement of body armor for the third officer. This equipment has a less than five-year life span.

While investigating a motor vehicle crash, Corporal Pearson made an arrest for possession of marijuana second degree.

Chief Money made eight arrests on warrants. Chief Money investigated one motor vehicle crash.

Chief Money, Chief Hall, Colonel Smith, Corporal Justin Pearson, and Firefighter Trenton Hall determined that a structure fire was unintentional and likely started by smoking materials.

Corporal Pearson investigated a criminal mischief case, but the victim declined to prosecute. Corporal Pearson investigated three motor vehicle crashes.

Colonel Smith and Corporal Pearson investigated a false report. The elderly resident was having mental health issues.
