Projects and Operations

Colonel Smith notified 14 property owners to attend court regarding Cottonwood Clean City Ordinances. One resident was issued a summons to appear. Two properties have come into compliance since notifications have begun. A court session has been scheduled on January 20, 2022, for these alleged violations.

Chief Money, Colonel Smith, and Officer Pearson investigated a case of domestic violence. The offender was arrested for Domestic Violence. Warrants will be obtained for Unlawful Possession of Drug Paraphernalia, Possession of Marijuana Second, and Unauthorized use of a Motor Vehicle.

Chief Money made a carrying a pistol without a permit following a traffic stop for speeding. Chief Money also investigated a motor vehicle theft and a domestic violence case.

Officer Pearson investigated a theft and motor vehicle crash.

Chief Money investigated a motor vehicle crash and Colonel Smith investigated two motor vehicle crashes.
