Council Meeting

October 19, 2021

Mayor Coachman opened the meeting at 6:00 P. M. followed by prayer then by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Council Member Capehart made a motion to waive the reading of the minutes from council meeting on September 21st and workshop on October 06th and except the minutes as presented. There was a second by Council Member Granger and the motion was approved unanimously.

Approval for the September financial reports were presented to the Council by the Town Clerk. Council Member Free made a motion to approve the reports as presented. A second by Council Member Granger and the motion was approved unanimously.

Colonel Smith presented the police reports for the month of September. There was a total of 158 calls for service, 08 reports written, 0 medical assists, 37 traffic warnings issued, 05 traffic citations issued, 0 traffic warrant, 0 drug arrest, 0 felony, 0 misdemeanor, 0 Arrests made and 8 auxiliary hours.

Discussion on mosquito spraying. Mayor replied that he had JC Autos here in town looking for a truck that will be set for mosquito spraying only. Mosquito sprayer will be put in back and it will stay there and will also be looking for a garage to pull the vehicle under to keep the sprayer out of the weather.

Discussion on roadside cutting the grass inside the city limits. Mayor replied we have sent a letter to Houston County Road and Bridge on requesting their assistance to cut the roadsides inside the city limits. This has been approved and Danny Jernigan will start cutting on October 29. We will have to get someone independent cutter to cut Hwy 53.

Council Member Granger made a motion to approve the renewal on the Tax Revenue and Business License agreement. A second by Council Member Free and the motion was approved unanimously.
