After the clerk talked to the County about the plastic pipe the answer was NO. Mayor was contacted and he asked the Clerk to call the remaining Council Member's that were at last night meeting to vote over the phone which way they wanted to go either concrete or metal. Mayor voted concrete, Council Member Granger was called, and he asked to have a special meeting for further discussion, Mayor was contacted again, and he said to call the other members. Council Member Capehart voted concrete. Council Member Hackney voted concrete and Council Member Free voted concrete. 4 Voted for Concrete, Mayor said to prepare the letter to the county to go forward.

Council Member Granger wanted to revote on the pipe for Houston Street because he said the concrete pipe was going to be over \$25,000.00 more than the metal pipe. Council Member Granger and Council Member Hackney also complained they did not want to vote over the phone anymore. The mayor replied that the concrete pipe job is \$34,110.40 and metal is 21,652.00, the difference of \$12,458.40. Mayor also said that fine we will not be voting over the phone any more we will have a special called meet if needed. Also, a reminder no extra pay for the special meeting (FYI).
