Projects and Operations

Monthly Activity

Chief Money investigated the theft of vehicle. He located the vehicle and suspect near Wicksburg. The suspect was arrested and charged with theft of property first degree and placed in the Houston County Jail.

Chief Money, Colonel Smith, and Officer Pearson investigated a destructive animal call and cited the animal's owner for allowing the animal at large.

Officer Pearson arrested a fugitive during the investigation of alleged domestic violence call. The individual was wanted in Jackson County, Florida for burglary.

Colonel Smith, Chief Money, and Officer Pearson investigated a motor vehicle crash with injury. This investigation is ongoing.

All officers and one reserve officer worked during Tropical Storm Fred. Numerous downed power lines and downed tree calls were answered with roadways cleared. Officers worked more than 16 hours straight during this event. The HMMWV procured by Chief Money with the 1033 program was of substantial value in navigating tree blocked roads. After the storm had passed, one utility company declined to respond to calls for assistance from officers regarding downed power lines, and only responded the following morning. Another utility company worked closely with officers throughout the storm removing downed power lines and allowing officers to open roads.
