Projects and Operations

Colonel Smith, Chief Money, and Corporal Pearson investigated a motor vehicle crash with injuries on Cottonwood Road near Pinetree Street. The crash severely damaged a concrete sewer riser belonging to the Town.

Colonel Smith investigated a criminal mischief involving one neighbor who fired a shot with a rifle and the bullet struck and penetrated a chain link fence pole of the adjacent neighbor. The suspect also pointed the rifle at the victim as if to shoot her and according to the victim, the suspect "charged the rifle." This has been an ongoing issue but the victim in the case declined to pursue a warrant.

Chief Money and Colonel Smith investigated a leaving the scene of an accident in which a peanut wagon detached from a vehicle towing it and struck a fire hydrant. The fire hydrant was destroyed. The owner of the vehicle involved in the crash was determined and will be billed for the damage.

Colonel Smith and Corporal Pearson made a traffic stop in which the driver of the vehicle had been smoking marijuana. A marijuana cigarette was recovered. The driver was arrested for possession of marijuana second degree.

Colonel Smith made two arrests on alias warrants.

Chief Money investigated a criminal mischief second degree that involved damage to a fence. This case has been transferred to Circuit Court as part of an ongoing civil dispute.

Corporal Pearson investigated a motor vehicle crash. No injuries were reported.

Corporal Pearson made a traffic stop for a potential DUI and arrested the driver for DUI and unlawful possession of a controlled substance.

Chief Money, Colonel Smith, and Corporal Pearson investigated the allegations of harassment physical contact in which the suspect had inappropriate contact with a customer in a local business. A summons will be issued for the suspect.

Chief Money and Colonel Smith investigated a burglary of a residence. The case is ongoing.

The Halloween activities went well. The attendance was estimated at 500 persons.

Chief Money investigated an animal cruelty case. The investigation is ongoing.
